
RESULTS OF THE Q3 QUESTION INVENTORY

How much have you learned so far in ELAB?






 I'm not awful, but I have trouble keeping up in my ELA/ELAB classes.

What kind of writer are you?



What type of writing was the most difficult for you?




What type of writing was the easiest for you?


What specific skills do you think are the most difficult for you to master?
